Young Men's mentoring program following the Abba Conference in the Spring

Revamp ministry to home-bound including home-bound communion

Recreate card ministry

Recruit volunteers for Wednesday evening program for children and youth

Design church brochure for distribution to neighborhood including Jackson Walk

Implement additional Bible studies

Support SLT V in outreach to Aspell Recovery Center and prayer initiative

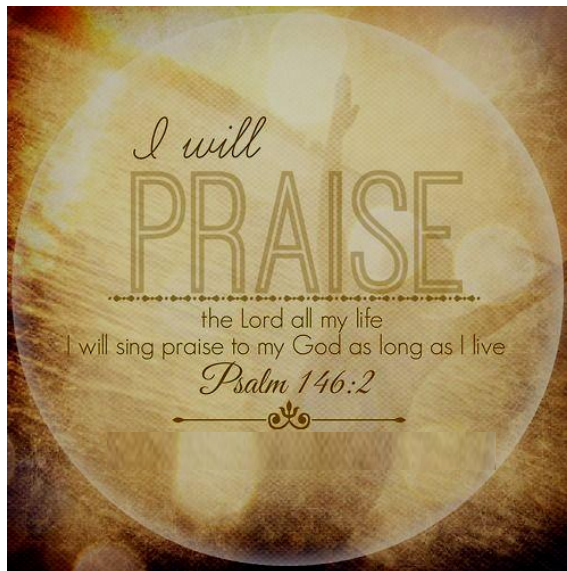
